PROGRAM DURATION

- ▶ It's a 4 day long On-campus program.

ESSENTIAL INFORMATION

- ▶ All IOP, SDP, FMP programs are fully residential. Delivery mode will be in person, on-campus. (except FMP Aquaculture). The HOT programs are Non-residential.
- ▶ Sessions are conducted at the Agrivet School Campus which is located at State-of-the-Art Agrivet Research Center housing Research Farms (Broiler, Layer, Breeder & Aqua), Commercial Farm, Advanced Analytical & Diagnostic Laboratories and Pellet Feed Mill.
- ▶ Agrivet School Campus is equipped with a smart classroom having interactive audio-visual display and high-speed internet connectivity.
- ▶ Individual travel & the cost of accommodation is not included in the program fees. Personalized assistance is provided through a dedicated Travel Desk. The team will assist each participant in finding appropriate accommodation in the hotels near the pick-up location at a specially contracted tariff. Alternatively, participants may book their stay on their own.
- ▶ Everyday local transportation in air-conditioned vehicles from a prefixed pick-up point to the training facility is provided. Pick-up and drop location for daily visit to Agrivet School will be informed well in advance.
- ▶ Everyday lunch, tea and snacks will be provided at the training centre.
- ▶ Study materials (Soft copy/Hard copy) and basic stationery needed for the course will be provided.
- ▶ Protective wears needed for biosecurity during entering the laboratories and Farms will be provided.
- ▶ All participants will get a Certificate of Participation after successful completion of the course.
